Lizzy said, "I sure did! It was so fun!"

If you think Lizzy told her friends a LIE, show me your RED LIGHT. If you think Lizzy told her friends the TRUTH, show me your GREEN LIGHT. (Kids show GREEN LIGHT)

Way to go! Let's all say what we Need to Know together so we can remember:

I Will (thumbs to chest)

Tell The Truth! (cup hands around mouth)

Grab Bag Cards (Fours)

Craig loves to play soccer. Craig's mom told him he could play soccer, but he could NOT kick the ball into the neighbor's yard. After playing, Craig's mom asked him, "Did you kick the ball into the neighbor's yard?" Craig said, "No ma'am," but really he DID kick the ball into their yard.

If you think Craig told his mom the TRUTH, show me your GREEN LIGHT. If you think Craig told his mom a LIE, show me your RED LIGHT. (Kids show RED LIGHT)

That's right! Even if it is hard or you are scared you might get in trouble, God wants you to tell the TRUTH!

Grab Bag Cards (Fours)

Jessie wanted to play outside, but his mom said he had to practice karate first. Jessie practiced his karate moves and then went out to play. His mom saw him playing and asked, "Did you practice your karate first?" Jessie said, "Yes, ma'am."

If you think Jessie told his mom a LIE, show me your RED LIGHT. If you think Jessie told his mom the TRUTH, show me your GREEN LIGHT. (Kids show GREEN LIGHT)

Way to go! If you will tell the truth, like Jessie, let me see your best karate chop in the air and say, "Hi-yah!" (Kids will do karate move and say, "Hi-yah!")

Grab Bag Cards (Fours)

Levi had never ridden a bike without training wheels, but he wanted to try! His babysitter asked him if he could ride without training wheels and Levi said, "YES!"

Levi's babysitter let him ride the bike in the driveway, but he fell down and got hurt!

If you think Levi told the TRUTH, show me your GREEN LIGHT. If you think Levi told a LIE, show me your RED LIGHT. (Kids show RED LIGHT)

That's right! We can hurt ourselves and others when we tell a lie. God wants us to tell the TRUTH!

Grab Bag Cards (Fours)



Piper wanted to play with her brother's ball. Piper's brother said, "No," but Piper was sneaky and took the ball anyway. When her brother asked, "Did you take my ball?" Piper said, "No."

If you think Piper told her brother the TRUTH, show me your GREEN LIGHT. If you think Piper told her brother a LIE, show me your RED LIGHT. (Kids show RED LIGHT)

That's right! Even if it is hard or you are scared you might get in trouble, God wants you to tell the TRUTH!

Grab Bag Cards (Fours)

Jamie wanted to draw a picture. She found her sister's school book and started drawing in it. Later, Jamie's sister asked her if she drew in her book. Jamie said, "Yes. I am so sorry."

If you think Jamie told her sister a LIE, show me your RED LIGHT. If you think Jamie told her sister the TRUTH, show me your GREEN LIGHT. (Kids show GREEN LIGHT)

Hooray! Let's all say what we Need to Know together so we can remember:

I Will (thumbs to chest)
Tell The Truth! (cup hands around mouth)

Grab Bag Cards (Fours)

Landon's mom asked him to feed the dog before he went to church. On their way to church, Landon's mom asked if he fed the dog and Landon said, "Yes ma'am."

If you think Landon told his mom a LIE, show me your RED LIGHT. If you think Landon told his mom the TRUTH, show me your GREEN LIGHT. (Kids show GREEN LIGHT)

That's right! If you will tell the truth, like Landon, let me hear you bark like a dog. (Kids will bark like a dog)

Grab Bag Cards (Fours)

Mia wanted to slide down the blue slide. Her dad told her she could not go down the slide but could play on the swings. Mia promised her dad she would not play on the slide.

If you think Mia kept her promise and told the TRUTH, show me your GREEN LIGHT. If you think Mia broke her promise and told a LIE, show me your RED LIGHT. (Kids show RED LIGHT)

When we do not tell the truth, it can hurt us and hurt others.

If you will tell the truth, let me see you pat your knees. (Kids will pat knees)

Grab Bag Cards (Fours)



When Jacob took food to his dad, did he tell the **TRUTH** and say, "I am Jacob," or did he tell a **LIE** and say, "I am Esau"? (Told a lie and said, "I am Esau")

That's right! Jacob LIED to his dad, and it hurt his dad and his brother.

Even if it is hard or you are scared you might get in trouble, God wants you to tell the TRUTH!

Grab Bag Cards (Fours)

Jacob wanted to be the leader of the family when his dad died.

Did Jacob make a plan to BE KIND to his dad or LIE to his dad? (Lie to his dad)

If you think God wants us to be like Jacob and tell a LIE, show me your RED LIGHT. If you think God wants us to TELL THE TRUTH, show me your GREEN LIGHT. (Kids show GREEN LIGHT)

That's right! If you will tell the truth, show me two thumbs up! (Kids will show two thumbs up)

Grab Bag Cards (Fours)

Willy Worm wants me and you to always tell the truth!

Let's all wiggle like a worm as we say what we Need to Know together:

I Will (thumbs to chest)

Tell The Truth! (cup hands around mouth)

Willy Worm's mommy said he could have ONE cookie for snack, but he ate TWO cookies. When Mommy Worm asked him if he only ate ONE cookie, Willy Worm said, "Yes ma'am."

If you think Willy Worm told his mommy the TRUTH, show me your GREEN LIGHT. If you think Willy Worm told his mommy a LIE, show me your RED LIGHT. (Kids show RED LIGHT)

That's right! Even if it is hard or you are scared you might get in trouble, God wants us to tell the TRUTH!
