

Race Manual

To build our race car, we have to follow the Race Manual. Let's get to work!

*Note: Adjust **Stickers** as needed to fit the **Sticker Scenes** at your campus.

Car
Body



- If your mom gives you a red popsicle but you WANT a blue popsicle, should you cry and pout or be happy with the popsicle you have? (Allow responses)
- We can show love to our mom by being happy with the popsicle we have. Let's all put our Car Sticker on our Race Paper (Kids will place a **Car Sticker** on **Race Paper**).

Tire



- Your friend has a shiny, new bouncy ball. You have a bouncy ball but it is dirty and old. Should you take your friend's ball or have fun with your ball? (Allow responses)
- We can show love to our friends by being happy with the ball that we have. Let's all put ONE Tire Sticker on our Race Paper (Kids will place a **Tire Sticker** on **Race Paper**).

Tire



- You picked up a yellow crayon to color with at church. Your friend picked up a red crayon. Should you take the red crayon away from your friend? (Allow responses)
- You can show your friend love and be happy with the yellow crayon you have until it's your turn to have the red crayon! Let's all put ONE Tire Sticker on our Race Paper (Kids will place a **Tire Sticker** on **Race Paper**).

Wheel



- If your small group leader gives you a red car but you WANT a green car, should you shout, "I want green!" or should you have fun with your red car? (Allow responses)
- We can show love to our small group leader by being happy with the car that we have. Let's all put ONE wheel on one of the TIRES (Kids will place **Wheel Sticker** on one of the **Tire Stickers** on the **Race Paper**).

Wheel



- If I say, "Give me that car," and jerk the toy away from my friend, am I being happy with what I have? (Allow responses)
- If I am happy with what I have, I will play and share with my friends, not jerk toys away and say mean words. Let's all put our other Wheel Sticker on our Race Paper (Kids will place **Wheel Sticker** on one of the **Tire Stickers** on the **Race Paper**).

Flame



- If you can be happy with what you have, let me see you pretend to drive your race car speedy fast around the track (Kids will pretend to drive fast race car)!
- When we are happy with what we have we are showing God and others love! Let's all put the Flame Sticker on our Race Paper (Kids will place a **Flame Sticker** on **Race Paper**).
